

## **A STUDY OF SYNTACTIC ERRORS IN ENGLISH PRODUCED BY NON-NATIVE SPEAKERS USING SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS**

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### **Abstract**

The study investigated syntactic errors in English produced by non-native speakers using social media platforms. To collect the data, the researcher analyzed based on the students' opinions in Whatsapp group. The participants of the research were the students of Islamic Institute Darul A'mal Lampung. There were 15 participants of English Education Department. The results showed that there were 15 syntactic errors based on their chatting. Syntactic error could be caused by intralingual factors, which are limited vocabulary knowledge, weak grasp of English grammar, sentence structure mistakes, punctuation errors, and confusion about different types of clauses. To reduce students' sentence errors, teachers can increase students' awareness of the differences between first and second language rules. Additionally, it is recommended that teachers explicitly teach sentence types and common sentence errors through sentence combination tasks. These strategies can be effectively implemented if teachers use engaging teaching methods and techniques.

### **Introduction**

In the globalization era, social media can be used as communication tool to communicate with others. In teaching learning process, students can improve their language especially in English. The varieties of media are the result of rapid technological progress and development. Social media provides many advantages. It is supported by (Justina & Phil, 2016) stated that using social media makes the user get many effects for themselves. There are example of social media. They include Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and WhatsApp. Among the mentioned social media platforms, WhatsApp stands out for its numerous features that help students enhance their skills quickly. It is enabling them to share pictures, videos, and text messages. (Ta'amneh, 2017) stated that stated that WhatsApp has spread for the most part among youngsters who are students and use it is as an amusement and entertaining device.

In addition, Whatsapp is an application that allows users to send a message through an internet connection. Besides, students can join in

groups to share and discuss something. It effects for improving their communication in written form. They can apply their daily status feature to make an English opinions in heir Whatsapp group. Sometimes, the lecture gives task in Whatsapp group to discuss about one of th object. Then, the students give their sugestions about it. For instance, they are lack of making correct sentence based on grammatically. They are no able to apply many sentences and less attention to proper punctuation. One of the reasons students make some errors is a lack of writing English comprehensive knowledge. Furthermore, another statement support the previous reserch that was conducted by (Saputra, 2021). He conducted research to discussed the data about students' sentence errors when they create an English story on WhatsApp. The data obtained from e-Perpusnas, research gate, science direct, and Google scholar. Interlingual and intralingual factors are error sources of students' WhatsApp daily status.

WhatsApp is a messaging application, similar to other social media platforms like Facebook, Twitter, Line, and Telegram. It enables users to send text messages, images, videos, and even make video calls, all via an internet connection. WhatsApp can be utilized as a tool for teaching and learning due to its various features. According to (Maulina dkk., 2021), WhatsApp can uphold unconstrained correspondence, the trading of pictures, and the sharing of catching video cuts in instructing and learning exercises.

In addition, (Alshammari dkk., 2017) states that WhatsApp is an informing application for savvy gadgets that can be utilized as an option in contrast to SMS. However, like other applications, WhatsApp also has its limitations. Unlike platforms such as Zoom or Google Meet, it does not support video conference presentations. While WhatsApp offers a video call feature, it isn't ideal for presentations due to the limited number of participants it can accommodate and the lack of a feature to share or display materials during the call.

In English language context, the written message in understood if the sentences are constructed according to the rules of syntax. Therefore, ny disagreement with the syntactic rules is called syntax errors. In writing, syntax complexity is defined as the ability to produce writings that present the ideas and the large chunks of information blended together with the use of subordinate and embedded subordinate clause (Sotillo, t.t.)

Errors occur when students frequently do not use the structure of language correctly (Calanoga & Arellano-Tamayo, t.t.). Errors are consistent mistakes in grammar that reflect students' understanding of the target language. Errors reveal how students acquire a language, helping teachers to define learning objectives and enhance their instructional strategies. It can be supported by Errors can reflect students' proficiency in the target language and provide insights into teaching methods, the effectiveness of instruction, and evaluation strategies.

Besides, another previous research was conducted by (Yusuf dkk., t.t.) which states that the students' error when their mother tongue influences their language development. To sum up, the causes of students' sentence errors are incomplete knowledge and influenced by mother tongue. The Error Analysis procedures were used to analyze the grammatical errors in the students' essays. The errors were classified into omission, addition, misformation, and misordering categories, which are based on the surface strategy taxonomy. The results showed that the most dominant errors committed by the students were of the omission type (61.04%), followed by misformation (18.78%), addition (16.85%), and misordering (3.31%).

The last previous research was conducted by (Ngangbam, 2016), the study examined the English syntactic problems persistent in the written performance of freshmen English language class of Mutah University. The results showed performance problems committed in this study were due to mother-tongue interference, misuse sentence fragment, overuse, lack of grammatical knowledge, formation and development errors.

Based on the description above, the researcher will focus on a study of syntactic errors in English produced by non-native speakers using social media platforms. The students make a Whatsapp group and the researcher analyzes their sentences based on the grammatically. It includes on syntactic sentences errors in English that produced by the students of Islamic Institute of Darul A'mal Lampung using Whatsapp platforms.

## **RESEARCH METHODOLOGY**

The research design of this study is qualitative; this design is known to focus on understanding social phenomena from the perspective of the participants in the study. Method consists of the type of research, data, and technique of collecting data, instrument, procedure, and analysis method of data. Students' sentences error on WhatsApp is the main focus in this study that selected by the researchers. The subject of the research is the students of English Education Department that consist of 15 participants at Islamic Institute Darul A'mal Lampung. Since, the study focuses at investigating the problematic areas of syntactic errors committed in writing compositions, the researcher postulated a set of syntactic error categories to be analysed. They are noun-phrase errors, sentence structures errors, and word order errors. The data was analyzed by steps as follows; data collection, identification of errors, classification of errors, a statement of errors frequency, and methods of collecting data.

## **FINDING AND DISCUSSION**

### **FINDING**

The study analyzed the syntactic errors found in students' sentences produced by non-native speakers on social media platforms, specifically focusing on Whatsapp. The data were collected from 15 students of their

sentences on Whatsapp group. The errors were categorized based on Richard's Theory (Richards, 1971) including subject-verb agreement, tense error, sentence fragment, run-on sentence, and misordering. The data were classified below. They were as follows;

## DISCUSSION

Based on the data above, there were 15 opinions based on the students' chatting in Whatsapp group. The students gave their opinions about social media. The results showed that there were 15 syntactic errors based on their chatting. Syntactic error could be caused by intralingual factors, which are limited vocabulary knowledge, weak grasp of English grammar, sentence structure mistakes, punctuation errors, and confusion about different types of clauses. Other contributing factors are low motivation, insufficient time for reviewing class materials at home, too much focus on basic sentence drills, and a lack of attentiveness in class. Furthermore, it's not surprising that students make errors in learning a second language due to intralingual factors, as this has been supported by previous research findings. It is supported by (Hussain & Hanif, 2013) stated that it was also shown that the errors made by students were a result of the internal processes involved in learning a second language, rather than the influence of their first language (L1)

The second finding relates to the epistemological aspect of this study. While previous research has focused on examining students' errors from their own perspectives, this study distinguishes itself by exploring the nature of students' sentence errors from the teachers' viewpoints. In other words, this research offers a more holistic understanding of the nature of students' errors.

The pedagogical implications of this study are quite clear. To reduce students' sentence errors, teachers can increase students' awareness of the differences between first and second language rules. Additionally, it is recommended that teachers explicitly teach sentence types and common sentence errors through sentence combination tasks. These strategies can be effectively implemented if teachers use engaging teaching methods and techniques that motivate students to take learning correct sentence formation seriously in the classroom.

## CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

### CONCLUSION

The present study investigated syntactic errors in English produced by non-native speakers using social media platforms. It could be concluded that the students faced difficulties in syntactic error. Syntactic error could be caused by intralingual factors, which are limited vocabulary knowledge, weak grasp of English grammar, sentence



structure mistakes, punctuation errors, and confusion about different types of clauses. They still confused to determined the subject-verb agreement in the sentence. To reduce students' sentence errors, teachers can increase students' awareness of the differences between first and second language rules. Additionally, it is recommended that teachers explicitly teach sentence types and common sentence errors through sentence combination tasks. These strategies can be effectively implemented if teachers use engaging teaching methods and techniques.

## **SUGGESTION**

Further the study may focus on comparing syntactic errors across diferent platforms like Instagram or Facebook, age groups, or proficiency levels. A longitudinal study could also explore whether users' syntactic accuracy improves over time through frequent online interaction in English.

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
